## All Schools - Ofsted Briefing

We are pleased to share details of an afternoon briefing which will be led by Ofsted on Thursday 20th January 2022 between 1:00pm and 4:00pm. The session will be held online via Microsoft Teams.

During the afternoon Ofsted will share advice and guidance for Headteachers on the following topics:

### **1:00pm - 1:30pm: Phonics for EY/primary practitioners**

Briefly explore why phonics is so important and what it is we focus on during a reading deep dive.



### **1:35pm - 2:15pm: EIF revisited**

Key messages about the Education Inspection Framework and principles of an effective curriculum.

### **2:20pm - 3:50pm: Reading in the secondary phase**

The reading curriculum is complex in secondary schools.

In this brief session we explore a simple framework that helps us conceptualise priorities in reading in this phase of teaching.

## School Visits Programme - BOOK NEW

In response to feedback from Headteachers in the Autumn term we have scheduled a number of opportunities for headteachers in Mansfield and Ashfield to access. The visits have been organised by Paul Stone the Primary leader for this project and focus on helping schools to experience different practice from schools with similar contextual challenges. We recognise the value in learning from the experiences of others and know that headteachers will gain a lot from visiting other settings.

Each visit will have the capacity to host 10 headteachers and your school will receive £200 towards supply costs and £100 towards travel costs for attending the visit. **School visits will last for a full day** and **there will be an expectation that headteachers also join a further meeting within a month of the visit**, to review the impact of this work and discuss any joint practice opportunities that have arisen.

## Early Language Training

Communication and language in the Early Years is an essential foundation for further development and achievement, but children too often have poor communication and language when they start school.

The Education Endowment Foundation has found that *“overall, studies of communication and language approaches consistently show positive benefits for young children’s learning, including their spoken language skills, their expressive vocabulary and their early reading skills. On average, children who are involved in communication and language approaches make approximately six months’ additional progress over the course of a year. All children appear to benefit from such approaches, but some studies show slightly larger effects for children from disadvantaged backgrounds.”*

We are pleased to offer EYFS and primary teachers, HLTAs, TAs and EY practitioners across Ashfield and Mansfield with fully funded L2 and L3 accredited training in speech and language.

The training will take place over 10 weeks of the current academic year and will involve a mix of webinars, self-directed study and a learning log amounting to 4 ½ hours each week.

# All Schools - Derby Research School

Established in 2018, Derby Research School (<https://researchschool.org.uk/derby>), based at Wyndham Primary Academy and backed by the Education Endowment Foundation, has provided exemplary support to schools in Derby and across the East Midlands.

The Research School is characterised by being outward facing, exploring what the research shows works best and engaged in evidence-based practice. We are delighted to announce that Derby Research School, will provide schools across Ashfield and Mansfield with a suite of CPD opportunities over the remainder of the current academic year. The support includes:

- **Secondary Disciplinary Literacy:** Following EEF's Improving Literacy in Secondary Schools Guidance Report, the sessions will focus on the critical themes around: assessing reading fluency and implementing interventions; explicit teaching of vocabulary and oracy across the curriculum; creating a 'love of reading' culture. Dates: 4 CPD sessions and 4 workgroups - Spring 2 – Summer 1
- **Leading TAs and TA Training** – Primary and Secondary: Responding to questions and reflections from previous programmes, we are offering this leadership support programme and bespoke training for TAs to support schools in how we apply a laser-sharp focus on how we are maximising funding, supporting and developing our whole staff and ultimately diagnostically meeting the needs of our learners. Dates: 3 Leadership Sessions and 6 TA sessions - Spring 2 – Summer 1
- **Primary Recovery Maths:** Working in partnership with the Maths Hub East Midlands West, Maths mastery specialists bring to life the NCETM Curriculum Prioritisation Materials. This programme will be completely asynchronous with materials to deliver within year group teams. Dates: Asynchronous material release - Spring 2 – Summer 1
- **EEF Supporting Recovery – Middle Leader and Senior Leader Professional Development:** This 6 module programme is funded by the DfE and delivered in partnership with the EEF. It focuses on evidence-informed leadership to support schools in light of the recovery agenda - support your school's approach to educational recovery, school improvement & next year's planning. Dates: 6 modules Summer Term

We have been delighted with the commitment and engagement of colleagues with the SEND & Inclusion project particularly given the ongoing challenges around Covid and staffing. Approaching 100 colleagues attended the Every Leader a Leader of SEND & SEND governance sessions with 60+ already signed up for our Every Teacher a Teacher of SEND CPLD this term (we encourage as many colleagues as possible to sign up for this virtual training)

Family & District SENCOs have completed their SEND Reviewer training and we currently have 23 reviewers who will continue to lead and support review activity across the locality way beyond the life cycle of this project.
