Introducing the Leaders' Learning Exchange

Now open to ALL state-funded schools in the region including academies and maintained schools.

The Leaders' Learning Exchange is a dynamic new opportunity for school leaders to connect meaningfully beyond their own settings. In recent years, peer working between headteachers in different educational institutions has diminished – this programme is designed to change that.

Through working in structured triads, hosting reciprocal visits, and coaching-led reflection, the Exchange creates a space for innovation, professional challenge, and mutual support.

Who is it for?

This programme is designed for:

- Headteachers seeking to build relationships beyond their own school or trust
- Schools that are ready and able to both host and participate in peer visits



- Leaders interested in sharing and discovering approaches to real-world challenges in education
- Leaders with a positive attitude towards collaborative learning.

Programme Structure

Launch Event

 All participating schools attend a joint launch event to explore the tools and principles that will guide the programme. This sets the foundation for collaborative working and trust.

Working in Triads

 Schools are placed in triads and take part in reciprocal visits throughout the academic year. These visits focus on identifying impactful practices and exchanging insights.

Time Commitment

 The programme requires engagement in a total of three half-day school visits (of which you will host one) plus preparation time for each visit.

Coaching & Professional Dialogue

• Each visit is underpinned by coaching conversations, informed by the work of Sir Jim Knight, that focus on learning, growth, and deepening professional practice.

Led by Trusted Leaders

 Our programme is led by trusted school and MAT Leaders who will shape and support your experience.
